Subject: Hurricane Irma Relief

Cardinal Daniel DiNardo of Galveston-Houston, president of the USCCB has asked the bishops in the United States to take an extraordinary collection the weekend of September 23-24th on behalf of those devastated in parts of the Caribbean and southeastern United States by Hurricane Irma.

These funds will be used to support the efforts of <u>Catholic Charities USA</u> and other church partners as they reach out to provide humanitarian aid in the form of water, food, shelter, and medical care. Funds will also contribute to long-term efforts to restore communities who have suffered widespread destruction. Another portion of the funds will allow the USCCB to assist the affected local Churches with pastoral and reconstruction aid in the Caribbean and the United States.
