Cristo Rey Sacramento is a Catholic college-preparatory high school located in California's Capital. Founded in 2006 it will welcome its 13th freshman class in August 2018. The school moved to its current campus in April, 2015; an excellent site that provides room for growth and further development of facilities.

Cristo Rey Sacramento is a member of the Cristo Rey Network, a national association of high schools providing rigorous college-preparatory education to young people with limited resources while promoting the Gospel of Jesus in work and action and fostering a joyous faith community. True to the Cristo Rey model, all students participate in a work-study program that helps underwrite the cost of tuition, provides practical employment experience, and channels their formal education into immediate workplace application. The school utilizes a longer school day and year to help balance the students' commitment to quality learning and work experience. Dedicated faculty and staff provide academic assistance and counseling to prepare students with a broad range of academic abilities to succeed in college.

Reporting directly to the Board of Directors, the President will be a dynamic leader committed to the mission of Catholic education and the Cristo Rey model. The President will be expected to demonstrate a record of executive and fiscal management, along with the achievement of strategic and operational goals. The ideal candidate is a visionary Catholic leader who can effectively articulate the school's mission to its various constituencies and work with the Sponsoring Congregations: The Sisters of Mercy of the Americas and the Jesuits (Society of Jesus).

The President is responsible for the development and implementation of the Cristo Rey and Catholic mission of the school. Preference will be given to candidates with a mission orientation that incorporates Catholic education and Cristo Rey ideals with a strategic vision for the development of all aspects of the school and students: mission, academics, work-study, finance, operations, admissions, and advancement.
