Liturgy Specialization – “My Soul Proclaims the Greatness of the Lord!”

This five-part series covers all of the essential principles and best practices of Catholic liturgy. The series is for those who are involved in a liturgical ministry including readers, Eucharistic ministers, catechists and musicians. Session #1, Foundations of Catholic liturgy, covers the Biblical roots and primary teachings of the Church on liturgy and is **especially recommended for parish liturgy committees**. The purpose of the series is to promote the “fully conscious and active participation” of all the faithful by forming qualified liturgical ministers to lead beautiful and reverent liturgies. \$45/session, or \$125 for entire series by Aug. 1 (\$175/series after Aug 1).
