Re: Liturgy Specialization – Introduction to Liturgy

Saturday, August 25 - part one of a five-part series in Liturgy Specialization. Drawing from Sacred Scripture, the Catechism, Vatican II, and other magisterial documents, this session – General Introduction and Overview – will introduce participants to the essential teachings of the Church with respect to liturgy. **This first session is especially recommended for parish liturgy committees.** Participants may register for this session only, or the entire series.
