How does it work during the school year?

1. **Register** by February 8, 2022
2. **Choose** a service project to perform
3. **Join** a live session and the chat:
 - Sunday February 13 - 7:00 PM - 8:30 PM. Interactive Live Session via ZOOM
 - February 14 - February 18, participate in the live chat, watch videos, perform your service project!
 - December 17 - 7:00 - 8:00 PM. Interactive Live Session via ZOOM
 - Pray the Rosary together February 16, at 7:00PM on ZOOM
 - Saturday February 19- 3:00 - 4:30 PM - Interactive Live Closing Session via ZOOM.
4. Find time during the week to perform your service project

How does it work during the school year?

- Choose a time to re-energize during your school day and watch the **Daily Video**.
- Connect with your parish Youth Minister or Catechist to set up a **check-in** time during the day. Check in with other teens using our *WhatsApp* chat.
- Participate in the **Live Evening Sessions** on Sunday, Thursday and Saturday with other teens, which includes games, prayer, talks, small sharing groups
- Parents: Watch the **"Parent Mercy"** video series.

Register by February 8, 2022 to receive a journal in the mail. \$10/participant. Each participant will receive a Journal for the week.

Parishes must registered 1 safe environment certified chaperone for every 7 teens.
