
Supervisor: Reports to the Chief Operating Officer or other manager as may be assigned.

Job Summary: As a servant leader; Ensures complete customer satisfaction through operational leadership and supervision. Responsible for revenue and expense budgets and delivery of cash flow and caseload targets. Responsible for recruiting, hiring, training and scheduling of staff.

Essential Functions:

- 1. Deliver our Ministerial mission of caring for the dead and providing the Catholic Funeral Rites of a Vigil, Funeral and Committal Service.
- 2. Responsible for the profitable operation of St. Mary Funeral Center.
- 3. Assist in creating strategic plans and implement policy, procedures and protocols to achieve goals and objectives associated with strategic planning
- 4. Create operational budgets and manage the business to meet budgeted goals.
- 5. Must be able to plan for Capital Expense needs for the funeral department.
- 6. Oversee all funeral services, prep room and crematory staffing, activity and operations.
- 7. Must be able to recruit, hire and retain Funeral Directors, Arrangers, Assistants and funeral support staff.
- 8. Develop, train and mentor all St. Mary's funeral department staff.
- 9. Participate in family meetings and services with Funeral Directors and Arrangers.
- 10. Accurately review, approve, prepare and process a variety of correspondence and documents including contracts, receipts, and other forms.
- 11. Maintain and assist in updating the GPL and CPL as needed.
- 12. Work with vendors to solicited bids and negotiate contracts.
- 13. Interface with community groups and attend community functions as needed.
