Re: Emergency Preparedness and Response to Target Violence training

The Central California Intelligence Center (CCIC) is offering two training opportunities covering a facility's response to a violent targeted attack. These classes are offered to public safety professionals AND staff/volunteers at schools and houses of worship.

This program covers a broad range of topics, including pre-attack threat indicators, responding to a targeted attack (including "Run – Hide – Fight" training), and basic emergency medical training including "stop the bleed" protocols and airway management. Each participant will receive a CAT tourniquet, the same torniquet widely used by first responders and military personnel. There is no cost to participate in this program.

The first class will be held on Saturday March 16, 2024, from 8:00 AM – 3:00 PM in Rancho Cordova (location will be provided to attendees upon completion of registration). Links for course flier and registration for this class are included below:
