JOB SUMMARY:

The Coordinator for Marriage & Family Life Ministry offers a variety of educational programs, events, services, and resources designed to promote the Catholic vision of marriage, human sexuality and family life. This position coordinates the supports parish-based marriage and family life ministries.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- **Natural Family Planning**
 - Provide support to NFP instructors through quarterly support gatherings and formation.
 - Promote NFP Awareness Week providing parishes with resource materials.
 - Keep an up-to-date list of NFP instructors; provide this list annually to all parishes and clergy
 - Coordinate and serve as staff to the diocesan NFP Board.
- **Marriage Preparation**
 - Support Marriage Preparation Coordinators by providing quarterly meetings, an Annual formation/training, and promoting the Diocesan Marriage Preparation Guidelines
- **Marriage Promotion & Enrichment**
 - Coordinate an Annual Gathering for Marriage Ministers for networking and formation
 - Provide Marriage Enrichment conferences and workshops
 - Promote the values of the Sacrament of Marriage and encouraging young couples to marry in the Catholic Church by providing workshops, talks, events, social media, etc.
 - Collaborate closely with Parish Catechetical Leaders and Youth & Young Adult Ministry Leaders
- Coordinating Large Events and campaigns such to promote marriage and family life.
- Perform other duties as assigned by the Director

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Education: Bachelor's Degree or equivalent in pastoral ministry, theology, social work, marriage and family counseling, and/or related field.

Experience: Minimum of three years' parish ministry experience related to marriage, family & respect life.
