Re: Free Advanced Threat Assessment Training

Kevin Smith with Smith Strategics will present a one-day advanced threat assessment training program in Rancho Cordova on Thursday, November 6.

This class, sponsored by the Central California Intelligence Center (CCIC), is directed towards school administrators and safety professionals but is also suitable for parish management. Smith's presentation will build on his behavioral threat assessment classes with strategies to assess and manage threat situations and will include an interactive exercise where participants conduct a mock threat assessment.

Smith is an engaging instructor in the behavioral threat assessment and response field with extensive experience as a prosecutor who has made presentations to law enforcement and private security professionals across the country.

ADVANCED THREAT ASSESSMENT: K-12 SCHOOL SAFETY

COURSE DATE: Thursday, November 6, 2025 | 0800-1700 hours

LOCATION: Mather, CA – *Address will be provided upon completion of registration*

COURSE DESCRIPTION: This 8-hour course is designed for K-12 school safety professionals and stakeholders, including law enforcement, SROs, teachers, school admin, school psychologists, mental health professionals and other school district personnel with security responsibilities.

The course is designed to equip attendees with the skills and tools necessary to conduct evidence-based behavioral threat assessments in the K-12 school setting. The course will focus on a proactive approach to preventing school targeted violence and address the unique challenges posed by a potential school-based violent threat. The course will also help attendees identify and apply appropriate threat management strategies, including mental health, administrative, civil and criminal strategies.

The course concludes with an Interactive Threat Simulation exercise during which attendees will conduct a threat assessment of a realistic school-based threat scenario from initiation to conclusion while receiving instructor feedback.

INSTRUCTOR: Kevin Smith has designed and delivered foundational and advanced behavioral threat assessment training courses to a wide variety of thousands of security stakeholders, including law enforcement personnel from the FBI, Department of Homeland Security, U.S. Secret Service, U.S. Department of Diplomatic Security Service, the Major Crimes Division and Threat Management Unit of the Los Angeles Police Department, military personnel, educators, school and campus administrators, corporate and private security personnel, mental health professionals, and human resources personnel.
