Re: 2025 Federal Non-profit Security Grant Announcement

CalOES announced the Federal (DHS/FEMA) non-profit security grant application opportunity for 2025. You may remember some confusion surrounding this same grant after it was initially released in August, apparently without coordination with CalOES which acts as California's state administrative agency for this grant.

The grant is available for physical and cyber security target hardening efforts for applicants that are 501 (c) (3) non-profit organizations. **CalOES requires that applications be electronically submitted to them no later than 5:00 PM on Friday November 21.**

This year, FEMA/DHS is offering up to \$200,000 per application with a maximum of three applications for each entity depending upon how many locations the applicant controls (previously, the Federal grant was \$150,000 per application).

CalOES will host three webinars (Wednesday November 5 from 1:00-3:00 PM, Thursday November 6 from 10:00 AM - 12:00 PM, and Wednesday November 12 from 1:00 – 3:00 PM) for interested applicants. I strongly suggest participating in at least one of these programs to learn about the application process.

New Grant Opportunity from Cal OES

Fiscal Year (FY) 2025 Nonprofit Security Grant Program (NSGP)

Description/Eligibility:

The NSGP is focused on physical/cyber security, and facility/target hardening of nonprofit organizations at risk of a terrorist or other extremist attack.

Restricted to California nonprofit organizations that are described under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (IRC) and exempt from tax under Section 501(a) of such code.

Grant Subaward Period of Performance:

September 1, 2025 – May 31, 2028

Submission Deadline:

The Application package must be received electronically, by **5:00pm (PDT) Friday, November 21, 2025**, to Nonprofit.Security.Grant@caloes.ca.gov. Application packages received after this time/date or received to any other email address will not be considered.

Available Funding:

\$26,227,947

Maximum Number of Application Submissions

Applicants may submit one Application up to \$200,000 per location for a total of \$600,000.
