Re: 2025 California State CalOES Non-profit Security Grant Announcement

CalOES has announced the State's (CalOES's) non-profit security grant application opportunity for 2025.

This grant is similar in purpose to the Federal (DHS/FEMA) grant that was announced last week. The State has allocated \$76,000,000 for target hardening efforts for non-profit organizations that "are at high risk of violent attacks and hate crimes due to ideology, beliefs, and mission."

Applications must be electronically submitted to CalOES by 11:59 PM on Friday December 12, 2025. While the Federal and State grant applications are similar, CalOES cautions that "Incomplete, scanned copies, altered or prior versions of required forms, combined forms, embedded links of Proposal documents, or zip files will not be considered" and "Resubmitted, duplicate, or incomplete Proposals will also not be considered."

Like last year, CalOES is offering up to \$250,000 per grant application. Non-profit entities with multiple physical addresses can submit a maximum of two applications for a potential total award of \$500,000.

CalOES will host webinars on Wednesday November 12 from 9:00-11:00 AM, Tuesday November 18 from 9:00 AM - 11:00 AM, and Thursday November 20 from 1:00 – 3:00 PM) for interested applicants. These webinars are separate from those offered by CalOES for the Federal (DHS/FEMA) grants. I strongly suggest participating in at least one of these programs to learn about the application process.

FY 2025 California State Nonprofit Security Grant Program (CSNSGP) - Request for Proposal (RFP)

Description/Eligibility:

The purpose of the CSNSGP is to provide funding support for target hardening and other physical security enhancements to nonprofit organizations that are at high risk for violent attacks and hate crimes due to ideology, beliefs, or mission.

Restricted to California nonprofit organizations that are described under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (IRC) and exempt from tax under Section 501(a) of such code.

Grant Subaward Period of Performance:

March 1, 2026 – December 31, 2027

Submission Deadline:

The proposal must be received electronically, by **11:59pm (PDT) Friday, December 12, 2025**, to CSNSGP@caloes.ca.gov. Proposals received after this time/date or received to any other email address will not be considered.

Available Funding:

\$76,000,000

Maximum Number of Proposal Submissions

- Individual Applicants may submit one (1) Proposal up to \$250,000 per location for a total of \$500,000.
- Support Services (SS) Applicants may submit one (1) Proposal up to \$500,000 solely for SS funding to provide support to other eligible nonprofits.
