We offer two tailored opportunities to join this vital pastoral initiative:

- A virtual gathering for parish pastoral councils on Thursday, February 5, 2026 from 5:30 PM to 8:30 PM (via Zoom, with link to be provided)
- And a day-long in-person retreat for parish staff teams on Friday, February 6, 2026, from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM at Divine Savior Parish in Orangevale, CA.

Both sessions will include prayer, reflection, and practical training on Church teachings and pastoral resources. We will hear from clinicians and ministry experts, share experiences in small groups, and develop concrete ways to integrate mental health ministry into parish life. Many families today are confronting a range of mental health issues. The proposed sessions will equip parish communities as havens of hope and healing.

Pope Francis's encyclical *Dilexit Nos*, presents the **Sacred Heart of Jesus** as the ultimate source of mercy and healing for all who suffer, loving us "to the end" and inviting us to console the afflicted as He did. These "Healing & Hope" sessions will provide you and your collaborators with tools for transforming parishes into sanctuaries of pastoral care and companionship.
