



Franciscan Sisters Celebrate!

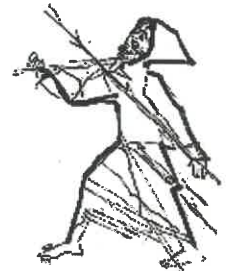
St Francis of Assisi Parishioners in Sacramento celebrated their first mass in the church in April of 1898. In July of 1898, the first Secular Franciscans in the parish were professed. Three years later, in 1901, the Sisters of St Francis of Penance and Christian Charity came to California from Stella Niagara, New York, to teach at St. Francis Parish School for a stipend of \$120 a year per Sister – that was over a hundred years ago!

In 2026, the Franciscan Sisters celebrate 125 continuous years of ministry on the West Coast, and it all started here in Sacramento at St. Francis of Assisi Parish!! Come and join us for two 125th anniversary events for a year of jubilee and celebration!
