Re: DHS/FEMA non-profit security grant announcement

Last week I distributed information about the June 24 DHS/FEMA notice of funding opportunity (NOFO) announcement for the federal non-profit security grant. This announcement came without an application deadline and did not have a submission link to CalOES, the state administrative agency responsible for collecting applications from non-profits in California.

On June 25, CalOES advised me that they did not have a timeline for this grant's processing cycle and that information about the application deadline and workshop/webinar schedules would be "forthcoming."

On Monday June 29, CalOES released the timeline and application material for this grant. This information was sent after the weekly Diocese bulletin to parishes and schools had been sent distributed for the week of June 29 – July 3.

Per CalOES, the deadline for parishes or schools to submit applications for the FY2026 federal non-profit security grant is no later than 5:00 PM on Friday July 10, 2026. CalOES scheduled three informational webinars last week.

The attached CalOES grant announcement contains application information and links for the investment justification and vulnerability assessment worksheets. Please note the instructions for opening the investment justification forms in the bullet points below the link.

I realize this is an extraordinarily short application period. A similar situation occurred last year when the FY2025 grant was announced with what appeared to be no coordination with CalOES. The results for the FY2025 grant are still pending.

New Grant Opportunity from Cal OES

Fiscal Year (FY) 2026 Nonprofit Security Grant Program (NSGP)

Description/Eligibility:

The Department of Homeland Security/Federal Emergency Management Agency announced the FY 2026 NSGP in the amount of \$300,000,000, available nationwide for nonprofits. California's allocation amount for nonprofit organizations is \$28,933,441.

The NSGP is focused on physical/cyber security, and facility/target hardening of nonprofit organizations' facilities at risk of a terrorist or other extremist attack. Nonprofit organizations that are eligible under the FY 2026 NSGP are those organizations that are described under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 and exempt from tax under Section 501(a) of such code.

Grant Subaward Period of Performance:

September 1, 2026 – May 31, 2029

Available Funding:

\$28,933,441

Maximum Number of Application Submissions

Applicants may submit one Application up to \$200,000 per location for a total of \$600,000.

Submission Deadline:

The following three (3) Application documents must be submitted as one email to the following email address: Nonprofit.Security.Grant@caloes.ca.gov by **Friday, July 10, 2026, 5:00 PM PDT**. A completed Application package must consist of the following three required documents in a single email.

Only electronic submissions will be accepted. Application packages received after this time/date or sent to any other email address or by any other delivery method will not be considered. **Incomplete, scanned copies, altered or prior versions of required forms, combined**

forms, embedded links of Application documents, or zip files will not be considered. Please ensure that your Application package email submission is accurate and complete before sending. **Resubmitted, duplicate, or incomplete Applications will also not be considered.**

If applying to multiple locations, submit a separate email containing the three required documents for each location.

Note: Cal OES anticipates FEMA to announce the FY 2025 NSGP awardee allocations soon. Nonprofit organizations that applied for the FY 2025 NSGP may also apply for the FY 2026 NSGP. If nonprofit organizations choose to also apply for FY 2026 NSGP funding, they must comply with the FY 2026 NSGP submission requirement as indicated in this announcement. However, if it is determined that your organization is selected for FY 2025 NSGP funding, Cal OES will communicate with FEMA.
