Re: School vulnerability assessment training

The Central California Intelligence Center (CCIC), part of our regional threat assessment center, is offering a free one-day vulnerability assessment training program for school personnel on September 30, 2026, in Davis.

Vulnerability assessments are a required element in both the federal and state non-profit security grant applications and are an important part of understanding a school's overall security condition and for planning effective improvements.

Participants will learn the CCIC's method of performing vulnerability assessments covering pre-assessment meetings with facility operators, site inspections, target hardening options, and assessment presentations.

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VULNERABILITY ASSESSMENTS FOR SCHOOLS

This eight-hour introductory course was created by the State Threat Assessment System to familiarize students with the fundamental concepts of vulnerability assessments. This course explains one method for completing a vulnerability assessment that is used by fusion centers in California. This course examines the following topics: pre-assessment meetings, field assessments (vulnerabilities and mitigation options), reports, brief back meetings, and resources.
